

Special events

Several areas in the Garden are suitable for private or corporate functions.

All such functions must have prior approval through the Coffs City Council.

Political events and functions that conflict with the serene atmosphere of the Garden or the maintenance of its unique and beautiful collections will not be approved.

The fee payable will vary depending on the type of function and what equipment is used.

Conditions will be imposed to ensure that other Garden users and neighbours are not unduly disturbed.

How to book your wedding

Contact the coordinator in the City Council: (02) 66484542.

Approval by the City Council is always required prior to the date, and bookings are on a "first come, first served basis.

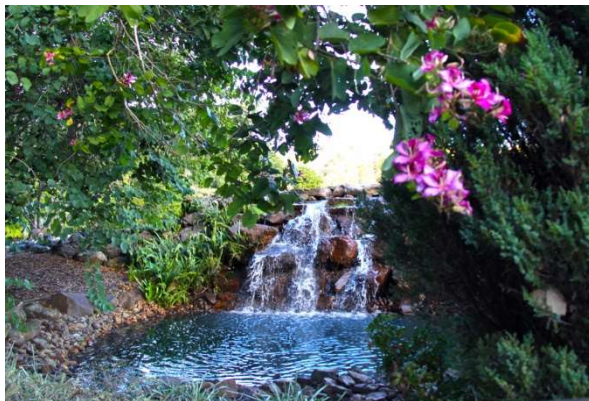
The Botanic Garden is Council controlled land and conditions apply.

Private vehicles must not be driven into the Garden.

The set up and removal of any equipment and accessories is your responsibility.

Alternative arrangements must be kept in mind as there may not be sheltered areas available in the Garden in the event of wet weather.

The Garden closes at 5 pm every day and all people must leave by then.

Just 1 km from Coffs Harbour CBD, the Botanic Garden is not only a stunning backdrop for your wedding but also very convenient for your guests.

There is plenty of parking, and our people mover may be booked to drive the bridal party and less able guests to the location of your choice.

Where can I choose?
Before selecting the actual location, check the standard conditions of the Council and discuss these with your celebrant.

Garden entrance area.
The Pavilion, to the left, blends into the natural beauty of the Garden. It is suitable for both large and small groups.



To the right is a smaller lawn area giving a more secluded spot for small groups. Both these areas are close to the car park on level ground for easy access.

The Northern Area.

Here there are several choices:

- ✚ the Sensory Garden is a favourite;
- ✚ the lake or waterfall area;
- ✚ the Chinese pagoda;
- ✚ the Japanese Pavilion or garden;
- ✚ the new North American pavilion.

With colourful plants in bloom at different times of the year, these may form a striking background for photographs.

For weddings in these areas, the use of the "people mover" is included as part of the fee as they are 500 to 600 m. from the entrance.

Where does the money go?

All fees are paid to the Friends of the Garden. Fees may be paid either at the Information Centre in the Garden, or posted to the Friends:
PO Box 648 Coffs Harbour.

The Friends of the Botanic Garden is a not-for-profit corporation, and all money is used for Garden upkeep and improvements.

People Mover and Chairs

When the people mover is provided it comes with a driver from a member of the Friends.

It is normally available for the bridal party and the less able, but we do not expect to carry large numbers of people.

White plastic chairs are available at \$2 per chair which must be paid for in advance.

The chairs will be taken to your wedding location prior to your ceremony ready for you to put into your desired arrangement.
